1. Prolongation of resolution adoption

- a. EU Agencies Duccio Triolo
 Updated version is presented, taking the earlier comments into account.
 Further amendments are proposed.
 Unanimously approved as amended.
- b. Health Services Monica Ermolli
 Updated version is presented, taking the earlier comments into account.
 Adopted by large majority 1 abstention, no votes against.
- c. Permanent jobs for permanent tasks Bernd Loescher Last version is introduced.
 Amendments are proposed, further discussion on the text.
 Vote: removal of the section salary tension: 19 in favour, 23 to maintain, 3 abstentions – section maintained.
 Approved by large majority – 1 abstention, no votes against.
- d. European Parliament introduced by Laura Bechi (in the absence of the authors) Proposal for resolution arrived late & difficult to discuss possible amendments in the absence of the authors Vote: 22 to send to 1st meeting of FC; 11 in favour of turning it into a motion – document will be sent to the 1st meeting of the FC.
- e. Information paper: Future of the Trade Union Will be further amended by the members of the working group and submitted to the FC for further processing.
